Terms:

In tempo di Walzer - in Waltz time Grazioso (zierlich) - graceful Morbido (locker) - soft, relaxed Scherzoso (neckisch) - teasing

Considerations:

- Triple meter (waltz)
- Articulation
- Characters: playful, teasingly, delicately, light-hearted
- Observe the rests in mms. 2, 3, 9, 10, 11
- Keep the eighth notes short in mms. 36 & 37
- Smooth slurs in mms. 5 &6
- Play triplet sixteenth notes melodically and rhythmically uncompressed (mms. 1, 4, etc.)
- Refine soft dynamics and lifted articulations

Study No. 6, Op. 33 Joachim Andersen. Adagio, Eighth note = 76

Terms:

Ben tenuto - well sustained Espressivo - expressively

Considerations:

- Rhythm and subdivisions
 - Many double dotted rhythms
 - Accurate triplet eighth notes (ex: measure 3)
 - o Practice: articulating the subdivisions, putting metronome on a subdivision
- Take beautiful breaths
- Sustaining notes full value, "touch the rests"
- Avoid harsh accents
- Good intonation on C#s
- Keep the grace notes in time
